RECRUITMENT TO THE GREATER MANCHESTER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Each Advisory Committee consists of both Magistrate and non-Magistrate members and should reflect the community it serves and the wider Magistrate community.

The Advisory Committee is currently seeking to recruit **FOUR** non-Magistrate members to join the Greater Manchester Advisory Committee.

Successful candidates will have good interpersonal skills and good judgement of character and will possess the ability to interview candidates for the Magistracy.

These roles are voluntary, although travel expenses may be claimed, if appointed. Applicants must have time available to undertake an initial two-day new member training course and also be available to attend four committee meetings and undertake at least 12 to 15 interview days per year.
